Village of Carleton (Owner) is requesting Bids for the construction of the following Project:

Village of Carleton Wastewater System Improvements
Contract 1: Cured-in-Place Piping Lining Improvements
Contract 2: Wastewater Treatment Plant Improvements

Sealed Bids will be received by the Village of Carleton through the BidNet/MITN electronic submittal process until 10:00 a.m. local time, **Tuesday, October 11, 2022**. At 11:00 a.m. local time, the same day Tuesday, October 11, 2022, the bids will be publicly read aloud via a Zoom Meeting administered by the Village of Carleton at the **Village Hall** located at **1230 Monroe Street, Carleton MI 48117**.

The Project includes the following Work:

Contract 1: Installation of 16,740 lineal feet of full length cured-in-place pipe liners within eight (8) to twenty-four (24) inch in diameter sanitary sewers and the installation of thirty-one (31) sectional cured-in-place liners ten (10) feet in length within eight (8) to eighteen (18) inch diameter sanitary sewer pipes, one (20) feet in length (8) inch diameter and two (15) feet in length of (18) inch diameter sanitary sewer.

Contract 2: Replacement of headworks, clarifier, and filter equipment, concrete rehabilitation around the WWTP, electrical, control, and HVAC improvements, and pump station improvements.
