Main Duties of DPW Worker

Lift shovels of cold patch, stones, snow, & dirt
Hand Dig holes
Remove and replace manhole covers
Drive backhoe, dump truck, snowplow, tractor, mowers, snow blowers, all different types of equipment (stick shifts)
Use chain saw and pickup and load different sizes of wood
Use push mower
Use street sweeper (controls on left side), hand sweep streets
Remove & install different size pumps from wet wells, chain falls, pumps weigh 500 to 1000 lbs.
Pick up brush along road, load into dump truck
Pull weeds
Rake leaves
Hand drive poles into the ground (street signs) with sledge hammer (12 to 16 lbs.)
Change tires and do vehicle maintenance on different vehicles
Move/Lift office equipment and furniture
Climb Ladders, do maintenance from ladders and man buckets
Paint, scrape, ready surface for maintenance
Use different type of lifts and place and remove flags on light poles
Load, unload and place road barricades
Work with different power tools, and hand tools
Clean windows, bathrooms, and sweep floors with hand broom in different buildings in Village
Change garbage bags
Clean storm drains by hand and with Vector Truck
Trim trees
Wash Vehicles
Burn brush pile
Work in manholes and in confined spaces
Computer work
Must be able to lift 50 to 80 lbs. either by self or with help if available
Must have a class C, B, drivers license within 85 days of Employment
Other duties as required.
