Instructions for Completing Application:	<p>General: Electrical work shall not be started until the application for permit has been filed with Village of Carleton. All installations shall be in conformance with the Michigan Electrical Code. No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected. When ready for inspection, call the Village Office providing as much advance notice as possible. Must provide the permit number and/or address for the inspection. If the inspection is not compliant and/or fails, additional fees may be required. Re-inspection fees are \$50.00.</p> <p>There will be a DOUBLE PERMIT FEE assessed for all requested inspections prior to obtaining appropriate permits, and /or work done without the benefit of required permits.</p>
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
